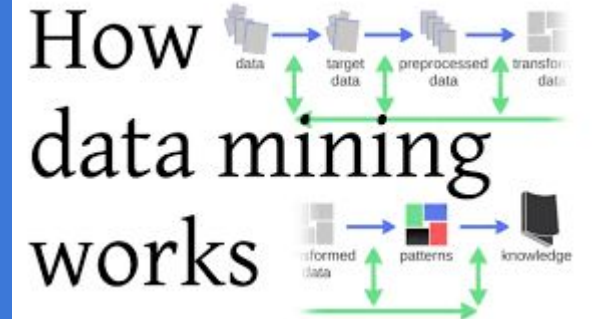
Online Safety
